

DORMOBILE LAND CRUISER



Land Cruiser

Travel where you will, and take your home comforts with you. That's the ideal. And the Dormobile Land Cruiser makes it reality through a simple formula – spacious compactness. This coachbuilt, glass-fibre bodied motor caravan has fixed standing headroom, is comfortably designed for 2, 4 or 6 people to eat, cook, sleep, lounge or travel in. Yet its purpose-built dimensions make it so spaciously compact that it costs no more to take across the Channel than a car of equal length (just a small extra charge at peak times for the added height). "Highly stable" comments the 'Motor' magazine – thanks to good weight distribution. Servicing? No problem – Bedford/GM Euroservice sees to that.

Let's take a closer look at that spacious compactness. Adjustable driver's seat, and equally comfortable front passenger seat. Behind, two single cabinet-built seats with deep foam cushions and backrests – easily converted into two double longitudinal seats. And further back, a 6 foot settee.

Electrolux refrigerator – standard equipment. Melamine surfaced table, cupboards, units, cooker (two rings and a grill); water electrically pumped to the sink from an underfloor 12-gallon tank; wardrobe/toilet; eye-level mirror – everything is to hand, but not in your way.

Full safety-glass side windows give double benefit: panoramic views of the country outside, and refreshing cool air inside, by courtesy of the sliding sections. And if the summer heat is still too strong, there's extra ventilation from the rear-door window and the two tinted roof lights.

It converts from dining-room to bedroom in a jiffy. One double bed, one single, plus a Pullman-type single above. Sleeping for four in super comfort. Two extra bunks are available as optional extras, and still the floor area and toilet are freely accessible. Carpeting is standard throughout, whilst underneath the floor of the rear saloon is covered with bright, easy-to-clean Vynolay.

Switch on the fluorescent light, swish round the pretty, striped curtains (Dynel fibre simulated-wool and flame-proof) open a roof-light ventilator – the glass-fibre body shell with double skin insulation will keep you snug. This really is a home on wheels. On holidays or weekends, at home or abroad, this is really living in style – Land Cruiser style.























Chassis: Bedford CF 22 cwt, 106" wheelbase with 2279 cc petrol or 1770 cc diesel engine and 4-speed all synchro gearbox (GM automatic optional with petrol engine). Hydraulic brakes all round (vacuum servo optional); 9" drums. Flat underfloor fuel tank, capacity 13 gals. 195 × 14 radial tubeless tyres.

Body: Steel front; moulded glass fibre to rear of cab doors.

Entrances: Rear and cab. Additional hinge down rear step optional extra.

Seating & Bedding: Driver's seat mounted on adjustable slides. Single passenger's seat. Immediately behind the front seats are two single cabinet-built seats, fitted with foam cushions and backrests. Built into the seats are flaps which, when folded out, create double longitudinal seats. Alternatively, a double bed 72" × 42" can be created by placing the table top in position between the seat boxes and covering it with foam cushions which normally serve as backrests. Further seating and bed accommodation is provided with a longitudinal settee 72" long on the left hand side. The backrest is hinged so that a Pullman type single bed 72" × 24" is formed above, which is supported on hinged steel tubes. A detachable safety rail is provided for the upper bunk. 5th bunk (60" × 33") and 6th bunk (66" × 34" approx.) available as extras (see dotted lines on diagram).

Cooker/Sink: 2 boiler rings and grill. Storage space for utensils is provided in cupboard units. Sapele melamine cabinet work.

Wardrobe/Toilet: The wardrobe/toilet is situated in the right-hand rear of the vehicle. The door is made as a dual unit, so that when used as a toilet the area is extended by means of the inner curtain. A Mini-Elsan Toilet can be supplied as an optional extra. A domestic mirror is fitted as standard.

Water: Water is pumped to sink by 12v electric unit.

Refrigerator: Fitted as standard. Cupboards: Large shelf provided over cab area, 3 cupboards over cooker/sink area and lockers under seats. All unit finish in Sapele melamine laminate.

Table: Removable table with folding legs. Melamine finish. Stowed in wardrobe and freestanding for use inside or out.

Upholstery: Orange coloured Nylon fabric on foam cushions and squabs.

Linings and Curtaining: Body sides from waist to roof lined in white plastic finisher. Curtains fitted to all windows on sliding runners. Loose curtain for screen.

Floors: Cab: tufted carpet. Body: floor surfaced with Vynolay with removable carpet.

Gas: Provision is for one 6 lb GAZ cylinder in metal container set in the floor.

Lighting: Fluorescent lamp in centre of roof. An internal lamp is fitted centrally above windscreen. **Safety Belts:** For driver and front passenger. **Heater/Demisters & Screen Washers:** Are standard equipment.

Body Colours: Dormobile white, with second colour from Dormobile range as an optional extra. **Dimensions:**
