Of space

A big-big load deck gives seventy cubic feet of money-earning loadspace. And it's all usable space. The low loading level (508 mm.) and big wide, full width rear doors make it safe, fast and easy to load and unload whenever the need.

Of power



The 1256 cc. engine is a real lionhearted puller, low stressed for long life and fitted with a 17 mm. carburettor for real fuel economy. The HA thrives on the cheapest fuel. From the four-speed all synchromesh gearbox to the tight 9·14 m. turning circle the HA is an easy-to-drive power-in-hand van that just keeps on going — whatever the conditions — whatever the load.

Of strength



After endless tests on the rough, tough Bedford test tracks, the HA has really proved itself. It's as strong as a lion – and nearly half a million on the road have proved it!

Of economy

Of elegance



A hard working van can look handsome – the HA has proved it. The clean lines, elegant and compact design can be recognised on the road everywhere. Ideally suited to carry your name-style and available in an attractive range of colours, the HA van can be a splendid courier for your business – wherever you are.



HAE light van



The HAE light van has a comfortable and roomy cab with a well upholstered seat with seat belt. Gives a natural driving position with good all-round visibility. The wide doors, wind-up windows, unique draught-free ventilation, easy-to-hand short floor-mounted gearchange and all synchromesh gearbox ensure tireless driving all through a busy day. There is a fitted heater too for extra comfort.

The four cylinder 1256 cc. power unit runs at its peak on the lowest cost fuels. Spare wheel and tool kit are locked safely away under the body floor, 61 cubic feet (1·73 m³) of load capacity in the well designed body gives big-big load space with 9 cubic feet (0·25 m³) more space available beside the driver if necessary.





A seat conversion kit is available and provides two additional seats behind the driver.

When the rear seat is not in use it folds flat with the floor leaving a completely flat loading area for normal van use. The front passenger seat is an optional extra.

A light, strong ladder rack, specially designed for both vans, can be fitted or dismantled in a matter of minutes. It spreads the load evenly and will not scratch or otherwise mark the paintwork.





HAV heavy duty van



The heavy-duty HAV van combines all the features of the HAE van with heavier rear axle, springs and wheel equipment giving an additional payload allowance of 369 lb. (167 kg.) including driver.

Additional features of the HAV heavy-duty van include a bright anodised grille; a parcel shelf; a cab rear floor mat; chrome instrument bezels; a bright metal body side trim and an interior roof lamp with door courtesy switches.

The same effortless loading and unloading as the HAE van is made through the wide opening rear doors and the low loading height of twenty inches (508 mm.).













The Beagle estate

The Bedford Beagle estate is a Dormobile conversion of the HAV van that enables you to truly combine business with pleasure.

For work – fill up the whole van area. For private use – just push up the rear seat and relax in the comfort of a four-seater. Even with the rear seats in use there is still 55 cubic feet (1.56 m³) of load space available, and easily accessible from the large rear doors.

The Beagle interior is smart, simple and exceptionally well-designed. The fascia is padded for safety and the instrument cluster is deepbezelled to minimise glare and reflections. Finger-tip control of flashing turn indicators, horn, main or dipped beam and headlamp flasher (operates main beam day or night), from the single arm below the steering wheel.















The Bedford Beagle is a handsome ambassador on the road, and easily recognisable by the attractive side flash finished in a contrasting colour

to the basic van colour. Full length side windows are fitted, giving the maximum of light to the interior and safe all round vision. No trouble

reversing the Beagle into a tight spot! The door windows are unique with their draught-free ventilation.

The Roma



The real breakthrough in motor caravan design – the Roma 2/3 berth de Luxe. By day – a fourseater saloon car. By holiday or weekend away – a uniquely compact yet spacious motor caravan. A delight for owners, young and not so young.

The Roma is an astonishing piece of





design. It's custom built, based on the supremely successful Bedford HA. Fitted with the famous Dormobile elevating roof, standing headroom is 6 ft. 4 in. (1930 mm.)! A storm-proof rear extension provides space for a luxuriously upholstered 6 ft. (1829 mm.) double bed converted from the rear bench seat and a further bed section. The made-up bed still leaves you room to move about. Blanket storage space is incorporated within the tailgate with more space behind the rear seat. Both front seats tip forward to give extra room — and on the de Luxe model an occasional rearward-facing seat is fitted to the back of the front passenger seat. A hanging wardrobe with fully enveloping curtain is fixed



to the nearside, and opposite it, conveniently positioned next to a moulded plastic stowaway basin, is a small grill cooker. Other features include storage lockers, clothing and sundries compartments, shelving, Camping Gaz storage space, interior electric light, curtains and full-length side windows with swivel-opening quarter sections.



The cushioned seating is covered in toning, wool-faced moquette and the flat floor is fitted with tough, textured material.

The Roma is a perfectly normal saloon car for four, transforming to a miniature home for travelling away for more than a day.



Engine

Bedford engines are lion-hearted pullers, combining flexibility and power with real economy. The HA engine is as modern as modern techniques can make it, yet works like a thoroughbred on the lowest cost fuels. Instant starting, smooth low-speed torque and quick acceleration make it a nippy and economical worker on the crowded roads of today. Diaphragm clutch and all synchromesh 4-speed gearbox give a rich flow of endless power.

And it looks after itself! Once the HA is on the road it stays there – day after tireless day.

When the HA just has to be serviced it is a simple operation. Easy access to full width of engine puts everything right to hand – then back on the road – Fast!
