
Honda Accord 3 door. Sporty perform ance in generous proportion.


Here is a hatchback that scores both in front and behind. Leg and head room are generous for front and rear passengers. And the fully reclinable, contoured front seats have built-in head restraints and tricot fabric inserts for all-weather comfort. They give positive support without interfering with shoulder movement and are adjustable fore and aft. Inertia reel seat belts, with 3-point fixing are fitted as standard.

The wide opening, high lifting tail gate allows easy loading and unloading. It is self-locking and easily unlocked—either by


a lever near the driver's seat or with a key. Two telescopic dampers support the tail gate when lifted; and these fit neatly into the rear pillars when closed to allow unobstructed rear vision. In the luggage compartment, parcels and valuables are hidden from view by a two-piece sturdy rear parcel shelf. And the fully-carpeted rear luggage area is easily increased by folding down the rear seat. Featuring tinted glass all round, a laminated windscreen, halogen headlamps, rear fog lamps and steel belted radial tyres, the Accord 3 door lives up to its lively performance in style.













Honda Accord 4 door. Compact limousine luxury.

Modest external dimensions belie a spacious fully carpeted interior that provides ample room for four and sufficient room for five with the rear armrest down. The four full-size doors are fully trimmed and equipped with arm rests/door pulls and passenger grab handles. Door openers and window wipers are flush-fitted and the rear doors have child-proof safety locks.


Seating is as with the 3 door model plus two fixed head restraints and a central arm rest for the rear seat. Magazine pockets are incorporated at the rear of the front seat. Illuminated ashtrays on the front passenger door and two rear doors are there for those who wish to light up. Further illumination is provided for the boot—one of the largest available for a saloon car of its size. The boot is lined with thick fabric and has two side pockets which can be opened either with a key or by a lever next to the driver's seat. Overall, the passenger compartment conveys an atmosphere of quiet comfort and discreet luxury . . . with everything that the 3 door has to offer in saloon car proportions.


Power at your command.

Switch on with a fully transistorised ignition system that assures long-life performance without the need for periodic adjustments. 
The snappy five-speed gearbox gives you an extra ratio of enjoyment and is ideally matched for smooth power transfer at all speeds. The same applies with the 2-

speed Hondamatic system, available as an optional extra; and its lower gear enables you to take off in a hurry.








Collapsible steering column has telescopic top shaft.









As a further measure to protection articulated two joint linkage has been provided.



Completely at your command. A quick safe stop with the lightest of pedal pressures is yours for the asking ... from servo-assisted hydraulic brakes with large diameter front discs and proportioned control valve (TCV) rear drums. Fail-safe operation is assured by a dual breaking system.

Somewhat up the market comes the Honda Accord, the nicest Japanese car I have driven and one which many manufacturers would have been pleased to produce.

Look out BMW, Japan's Honda motor firm is setting out to give BMW quality and at much lower prices.

Honda's latest 4-door, 5-seat Accord saloon is packed with quality features to support this claim. The Accord is delightfully smooth, quiet and untiring to drive and has some superb features like: a maintenance warning system that indicates when oil needs changing, when the engine filter must be renewed and when tyres need rotating, and a safety indicator panel telling you when a brake light has failed and which one, or if a door or the boot is not properly shut. The driver can also unlock the 16 cu. ft. boot without leaving his seat.

The front-wheel drive Accord Saloon is powered by a 100 mph 1600cc transverse engine; heating demists side windows and rear foot wells and rear seats have neck restraints and a centre arm rest.

An excellent car at £3,495 (manual), or £3,695 (automatic) including tax.

Fairly recently I was pontificating that often the price of good miles to the gallon figures was poor acceleration but with last weekend's test car, the Honda Accord four-door saloon, I discovered that it is possible to both have one's cake and eat it!

My own motoring over about 200 miles gave me an average of about 40 mpg .

Our first impression of the Accord was its sheer air of quality and quietness. After the fast and furious nature of the Civic, which is a real boy racer's vehicle, the Accord surprised us with its sophisticated design.

With its 11 gallon tank the Honda is capable of covering an easy 350 miles on a tankfull and its 8.4:1 compression ratio demands only 91 octane (3 star) fuel, although you might get away with 2 star if you are a gentle driver.

Popular Motoring

Honda have always been nonconformist. Their little gem, the N600, revealed a flair in design and manners which began to flower in the Civic. Yet even that is packaged and suspended in a way that cannot quite match the better Europeans. However, their latest effort has ripened to rival the very best. In the fundamental areas of performance, economy, handling and ride, Honda have caught up with one dramatic stride and the Accord's package is pitched neatly midway between the practical, compact saloons and the fun-loving coupés in its market sector. Its designers knew precisely what they were aiming at and have proved devastatingly successful in achieving

There are still some hang-ups on view, like unacceptable noise at main road speeds and mediocre underbody rust protection. Rear seat accommodation may be acceptable by Capri standards but compares unfavourably with some saloon counterparts. Likewise, getting rear passengers and baggage in and out will disenchant the more pragmatic prospective owner.

For others, its stylish lines and egoboosting image will outweigh these snags; they will consider its reasonable back seat and hatch back an appreciated bonus. There is absolutely no doubt in our minds that its road manners justify its sporty image - more discerning drivers will find it goes as well as it looks.

And the best of the new, sophisticated bunch is a high-speed, sporty. 1600cc model with an elegance usually found only in cars costing around £10,000.

The five-speed Honda Accord is aptly named.

In fact, at £3,495, it offers a standard of finish which is truly remarkable.

Mechanically similar to the 1978 3-door hatchback, the rear half of the new car has been redesigned to include two full sized rear passenger doors and a conventional boot. The result is a spacious, sporty looking saloon.

I must confess I was depressed by the Honda Accord. Thoroughly depressed in fact soon after I pulled out of the car park, and more depressed as I made my way Westward down the M4 with my travelling companion, a civil servant who lives a couple of doors away from me in Cookham.

Why depressed - because the Accord is so good.

To European eyes, the Honda Accord looks like the best thing yet to come from Japan.

Apart from the clean styling, Honda have set a new Oriental standard for handling, comfort and general driver appeal - areas often neglected by their fellow-countrymen.

What is beyond dispute is that it is a driver's car. By that I mean that it has enough performance to be interesting plus handling and roadholding good enough to make Ulster byways a pleasure to press along.

For my money it is the best Japanese car yet to come here and well up with leaders from the European factories which have longer and fuller experience of turning out such models.

Taking it further up the field are thoughtful additions like warm air demisting ducts to the side windows, concealed inertia reel seat belts and a lever down by the driver's seat to open the hatchback tailgate without having to fiddle for a key every time.

While Japanese cars in general have not until now been noted for their sure handling, the Accord is designed European style with all-round independent suspension, rack and pinion steering and a transverse overhead camshaft engine driving the front wheels.

Instrumentation in Accord.

Comprehensive and complete.


Forewarned is for safer motoring. And in the Honda Accord, all information dials, gauges and indicators are grouped together at eye level for quick-glance reading. Instrumentation that leaves nothing—but nothing—to chance.


The illuminated instrument binnacle comprises a tachometer, speedometer, fuel gauge and temperature gauge; and warning lights for open or half-closed doors or hatch back/boot, defective rear tail light bulbs, indicators, hand brake, oil pressure, ignition, choke, headlight high

beam and low fuel—plus tripometer reset knob. Impressive enough but we're not finished yet. Within the speedometer and connected to the milometer, is a maintenance indicator which tells you when the tyres are due for rotation and when the engine oil filter needs changing.

Elsewhere, on the right of the steering column is a single stalk in which the light controls are positioned. On the left, is a stalk for control of the 2-speed windscreen wipers, intermittent wipe and two electric windscreen washers.












Heating and ventilation control and AM/FM radio are illuminated and located for ease of operation at the centre of the dashboard. Also on the dashboard are controls for the rear window washer/wiper, heated rear window, choke, and a rheostat which controls the amount of light on the instrument binnacle. And illuminated clock and cigarette lighter completes the dashboard array. Other than telling you when you're tired and need a break, the Honda Accord has instrumentation that tells you about everything.






Environment of Accord. Safety in comfort.

The inside story of the Honda Accord is one of space technology with a difference: a wide, low shape that creates more space. The result? More seating width and shoulder room, allowing greater freedom of movement. And a large glass area for better all-round visibility and a comfortable feeling of spaciousness.


A beautifully controlled internal environment is assured by a heating and ventilating system of advanced design. It has a 3-speed booster fan and simple faciamounted controls. The 3 door features


four facia level vents and two lower vents in the front foot well; and the 4 door has two additional air ducts to the rear foot well. Side window demisters, connected to the windscreen demister system, make a valuable contribution to driving safely during rainy weather and in wintry conditions.

And to complete the picture, a heated rear window is standard in both models.


























